To apply, please log into your [SchoolAdmin Parent Portal](#) account. Click on "Apply for a new year" and fill out the Preschool or K application for the 2023-2024 school year for your child. This includes a \$100/child application fee, which will be applied to your registration fee at the time of full registration in February 2023.

Once your application is received, we will confirm receipt and help move you through the next steps in the application process.

Key Details:

- Who: St. Catherine Students Middle School Grades 6-8 (Please note, there are a limited number of spots. We will prioritize by grade, starting with 8th grade, and fill accordingly.)
- Experience Level: All (beginners to experts)
- Type: Ski or Board
- Dates: Jan 13, 20, 27 - February 3, 10, 24.
- Where: Alpental Ski Area up at the Summit
- Transportation: A charter bus through Puget Sound Coach Lines.
- Lessons: Lessons are required and go from 5:15 to 7:15 for 5 weeks with free ski after. The last night is free ski/board.

Pricing:

Based on completing this form you are committing to participating. The 1st week of November, I will send a sign up link to the Summit to purchase lessons and pass, AND request payment for the bus. Payment will be made directly to the mountain and to Puget Sound Coach Lines. Transportation cost is per student and will be based on # of students that complete this form. The program costs are non-refundable.

- Charter Bus: Est. \$225 + TIP (Approximate, will depend on # of students participating. This year I'm collecting bus tips at the beginning of the season. Our bus drivers transport your kids up and down to the mountain safely, tipping is appreciated.)
- Lessons: \$245
- Passes: With Ski Bus, families can purchase passes not available to the general public. Passes are as follows for 7-12/13-18.: Unlimited: \$459/\$589, LTD \$409/\$529; Twilight is \$339/\$469; Remedy is \$319/\$419.

Equipment:

Students provide their own equipment and cost is not included in the program. Helmets are required. Seattle Ski on Aurora is a great place to rent skis or snowboards for the season. <http://www.seattleski.com/>. Dick's Sporting Goods also offers rentals. Note, students must bring their gear with them versus renting gear on the mountain.

Other Details:

Skis/Boards will be dropped off before school. Students will keep their ski clothes with them and change right after school. The bus will arrive at 3:00 and volunteers will load gear. Bus departs promptly at 3:30. Bus leaves the mountain by 9:00 and returns at 10:00.

Tuition Assistance 2023-2024

The tuition assistance process for the 2023-2024 school year begins now and the application is officially open. If you think that your family may be in need of financial aid next year, please complete an application. Tuition assistance is available for Kindergarten-8th Grade only.

The entire process is completed online through FACTS. All applications are first reviewed by the Fulcrum Foundation, a fundraising arm of the Archdiocese. Once Fulcrum determines their assistance awards, then the St. Catherine Tuition Assistance Committee will review the applications and distribute financial aid for the 2023-24 school year. Some families may qualify for assistance from both the Fulcrum Foundation and the St. Catherine program, but only one application is submitted.

The application deadline is January 6, 2023. This is a firm deadline - all completed applications AND required tax documentation must be submitted by this date for consideration.

Immunizations Update

The Department of Health has updated the requirements for the 2022-2023 school year. Students in preschool or kindergarten who are four years old or older on September 1st are required to have the additional dose of DTaP, IPV, MMR and varicella vaccines before the first day of school.

Students with summer birthdays will have less time to get vaccinated before the start of school, so parents should plan ahead and schedule their child's vaccination appointment before the school year starts.

Attendance Procedures

If your child/ren will be absent from school, please notify the school office at attendance@stcatherineschool.net, as well as your child's homeroom teacher, no later than 8:30am on the day of the absence. Advanced notification of the absence (2-3 days before) is also greatly appreciated.

The safety of our students is our number one priority and the office will call home to verify the student's absence if a parent/guardian has not called or emailed.

If you know your child will be tardy due to a medical/dental/personal appointment, the office must be notified for the tardy to be excused. A parent/guardian must accompany a tardy student in to the school office to sign them in for the day.

If your child/ren will be absent from school for 2 or more days of school, please complete a [pre-planned absence form](#) and send it to attendance@stcatherineschool.net at least 2 weeks prior to the absences.

Regular attendance is important to the success of our students. Normally, illness, medical appointments and family emergencies are the only acceptable form of excused absence.
