Moving Up Mass

Please join us for our annual Moving Up Mass on the last day of school, Friday, June 17th at 9am. This is a special Mass we hold every year to celebrate our students as

they move up to the next grade (plus a few other celebrations). We will be holding the Mass outdoors (rain or shine) in the parking lot to accommodate all students, teachers & staff, parents & families.

- Students will be seated with their classes in designated areas. All students will be encouraged to bring a towel or small blanket to sit on for Mass.
- Preschool students & their parents please attend Mass so your kiddo has the chance to move up to Tigers or Kindergarten

After Mass is over, students will return to their classrooms to gather their items. We ask that parents return to their cars and then line-up in the carpool lane to pick-up their child/ren, or wait in the plaza if walking home. Teachers will walk their students out at 10:30am to say good-bye and be picked up.

Summer Small Group Counseling with Mr. Ward

The need for child and adolescent counseling has never been higher than right now, as it is a major challenge to find providers in the Seattle area. Although I am unable to meet with our students outside of school during the school year, I am thrilled to provide this option to work with your children outside school hours during the summer months. This small group will be a ton of fun and have many different aspects to it. We will learn **emotional regulation skills, participate in group sharing, and play many games**.

Sessions will take place each Monday from 9-11:30 am beginning on July 11th. Our last small group session will take place on August 22nd. Each session is \$50, but I am open to discussing a sliding scale.

Extended Care 2022-2023

Registration for Extended Care for the 2022-2023 school year is now open in SchoolAdmin.

Once you log into your <u>Parent Portal</u> account, you will be able to select 'Continue Enrollment Process' under your child/ren's name. The EC Registration Form is located in the 'Optional Steps' section. Please be sure to complete a registration form for each child in your family that will be attending EC next school year. A \$50/child registration fee is due at the time of registration and can be paid via SchoolAdmin.

Due to growth in student population and interest in EC, the rates for Extended Care for the 2022-2023 school year have increased. This allows us to hire enough staff to ensure a safe environment for all.

- Comfortable facilitating conversations with a group

Immunizations Update

The Department of Health has updated the requirements for the 2022-2023 school year. Students in preschool or kindergarten who are four years old or older on September 1st are required to have the additional dose of DTaP, IPV, MMR and varicella vaccines before the first day of school.

Students with summer birthdays will have less time to get vaccinated before the start of school, so parents should plan ahead and schedule their child's vaccination appointment before the school year starts.
