COVID Dashboard

In an effort to maintain and share an on-going record of COVID-19 activity, St. Catherine will now be reporting positive COVID-19 cases within our community through our COVID-19 Dashboard that is linked on the <u>homepage of our website</u>, under Quick Links. This dashboard provides current case counts for the past seven days and details how many of our students, faculty & staff are currently in isolation due to a positive COVID test. The dashboard will be updated regularly.

With the STC COVID-19 Dashboard in place, we will no longer send stand-alone notification emails to the parent community each time a positive case is reported. However, when close contacts are identified through our tracing protocol, we will still continue to notify affected families via email. We encourage all families to review our <u>most recent COVID plan</u> and contact the COVID Coordinators, <u>Kathy Cox</u> and <u>Amanda Lucero</u>, if you have any questions.
