The need for child and adolescent counseling has never been higher than right now, as it is a major challenge to find providers in the Seattle area. Although I am unable to meet with our students outside of school during the school year, I am thrilled to provide this option to work with your children outside school hours during the summer months. This small group will be a ton of fun and have many different aspects to it. We will learn **emotional regulation skills, participate in group sharing, and play many games**.

Sessions will take place each Monday from 9-11:30 am beginning on July 11th. Our last small group session will take place on August 22nd. Each session is \$50, but I am very open to discussing a sliding scale.

#### Extended Care 2022-2023

Registration for Extended Care for the 2022-2023 school year is now open in SchoolAdmin.

Once you log into your <u>Parent Portal</u> account, you will be able to select 'Continue Enrollment Process' under your child/ren's name. The EC Registration Form is located in the 'Optional Steps' section. Please be sure to complete a registration form for each child in your family that will be attending EC next school year. A \$50/child registration fee is due at the time of registration and can be paid via SchoolAdmin.

Due to growth in student population and interest in EC, the rates for Extended Care for the 2022-2023 school year have increased. This allows us to hire enough staff to ensure a safe environment for all.

Spring MAP Testing starts Monday 5/16 and goes until Wednesday 6/1. Tests are scheduled in the morning (1st-4th period). Students will not test more than 3 days in a row. Makeups will take place throughout this testing period. Students in 2nd-8th grades will take these tests. Data from MAP tests is important for monitoring student progress, assessing growth, and providing instruction that continues to meet individual student needs, especially as we look towards planning for next year. Please help make sure your child gets a good night's rest the night before each test and a filling breakfast that morning.

Please let your child's homeroom teacher know if your child will be absent, late, or leaving early on any of these days. There will be no tests on Friday 5/27 or Tuesday 5/31. Please let Ms. Elsner (celsner@stcatherineschool.net) know if you have any questions.

# Immunizations Update

The Department of Health has updated the requirements for the 2022-2023 school year. Students in preschool or kindergarten who are four years old or older on September 1st are required to have the additional dose of DTaP, IPV, MMR and varicella vaccines before the first day of school.

Students with summer birthdays will have less time to get vaccinated before the start of school, so parents should plan ahead and schedule their child's vaccination appointment before the school year starts.
